## 25, 50, & 100 Range Rules

- Always safety first!
- No metal targets
- Target must always be at back of berm.
- If you are on 50 range and want to shoot 25 yards please walk up to the 25 yard point to shoot from. DO NOT bring the target closer to you!!!
- NO special ammo or devices on the ranges! (See note below)
- Whatever you bring with you to the ranges to shoot at you take with you when you leave or drop off at the dumpster.

### **Sporting Clay Rules**

#### COST -

- \$5.00 per box of 25 shot shells shot
- MUST be paid for before leaving area!

#### SET UP -

- FIRST you **MUST** open all trap doors & windows. Failure to do so could cause targets to be thrown into "closed" doors and damage machines!
- **DO NOT** attempt to change any machine! If it appears something is wrong or if machine is empty please **LEAVE IT ALONE** and write a note on the Dry Chalkboard at the clubhouse.
- Each machine is clearly numbered and each station has a "menu" of the machines available. Please **put buttons back under plastic cover** to protect from rain!
- The "tower" has a control box with buttons labeled. Please close the lid when finished!

#### SAFETY -

- Safety is everyone's responsibility!
- The gun should be unloaded before stepping into station. The barrel of the gun should be pointed down range before it is loaded.
- Before leaving the station; the gun should still be pointed down range and empty with chamber open. The gun's chamber should be open at all times when moving from one station to another.
- Never move from one location to another location with a loaded firearm on any club range!

#### **FINISHING UP** –

- Please pick up all empty shotgun shells and place in the buckets provided on stands for recycling.
- CLOSE all doors and windows, even if you didn't open them!
- Note anything you feel important on the Dry Chalk Board at clubhouse and reference your "membership number". We will check it out and contact you if we have more questions.
- PAY BEFORE YOU LEAVE AREA! There are envelopes provided at bulletin board window. Please fill out your Name, Membership number and number of boxes fired.
- \$5.00 per box of 25 shot shells!

#### **MEMBERSHIP RESPONSIBLITY** –

- Clay targets are the club's greatest expense. The club **MUST** be paid for them. This range operates on the **honor system**. Please do your part and help the club.
- If you notice someone leaving the area with the windows and doors open, please ask them about it and also ask if they paid for their targets. It is every member's responsibility to help the club.

# Instructions for the Sporting Clays course:

You need to **OPEN ALL WINDOWS AND DOORS** before starting anything.

Each station has three targets with one button for each target. A "**Red**" button, "**Blue**" button, and a "**Black**" button. The "white" hood covers the buttons at each station.

There is a "menu" for that station that informs the shooter which three targets you can choose from to shoot at that station.

There are large numbers at each clay target machine. The shooter will look for the number of that machine and know where the target is coming from.

Shoot these targets, replace the buttons on the hook to keep them protected and then move to the next station. Then continue through the rest of the stations.

The **FIELD** is divided in into **TWO** parts; Stations **1** through **5** and **6** through **10**.

Please be sure to check with all shooters before you start to shoot..
